- 1967** First student representatives on a university senate
- 1968** First Executive MBA program
- 1970** SFU faculty Ted Sterling and Sy Pollack publish one of the first computing science textbooks
- 1970** First computerized course registration
- 1972** First interdisciplinary studies program
- 1974** First woman president of a co-educational university
- 1976** First formal credit programs in women's studies
- 2007** First mechatronics systems engineering program in Western Canada
- 2009** First international member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association NCAA-USA
- 2014** First professional master's program in computer science, big data specialization
- 2015** First bachelor of environment program

AROUND THE WORLD

- 1965** First North American university to establish an ombudsperson
- 1983** First Canadian university with a partnership in the People's Republic of China
- 2000 & 2008** First Olympic gold medals for Canada in wrestling. Won by SFU alumni Daniel Igalii and Carol Huynh
- 2011** First Americas MBA with partners in the USA, Mexico and Brazil
- 2011** First Executive MBA in Indigenous Leadership
- 2013** First virtual forensic criminal intelligence lab in North America
- 2016** First Canadian research university accredited in the USA (by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities - NWCCU)
- 2017** First Canadian university to house one of Canada's most powerful academic supercomputers
- 2017** First Ashoka U Changemaker Campus in Western Canada
- 2017** First civilian university with a field school with the NATO Defense College
